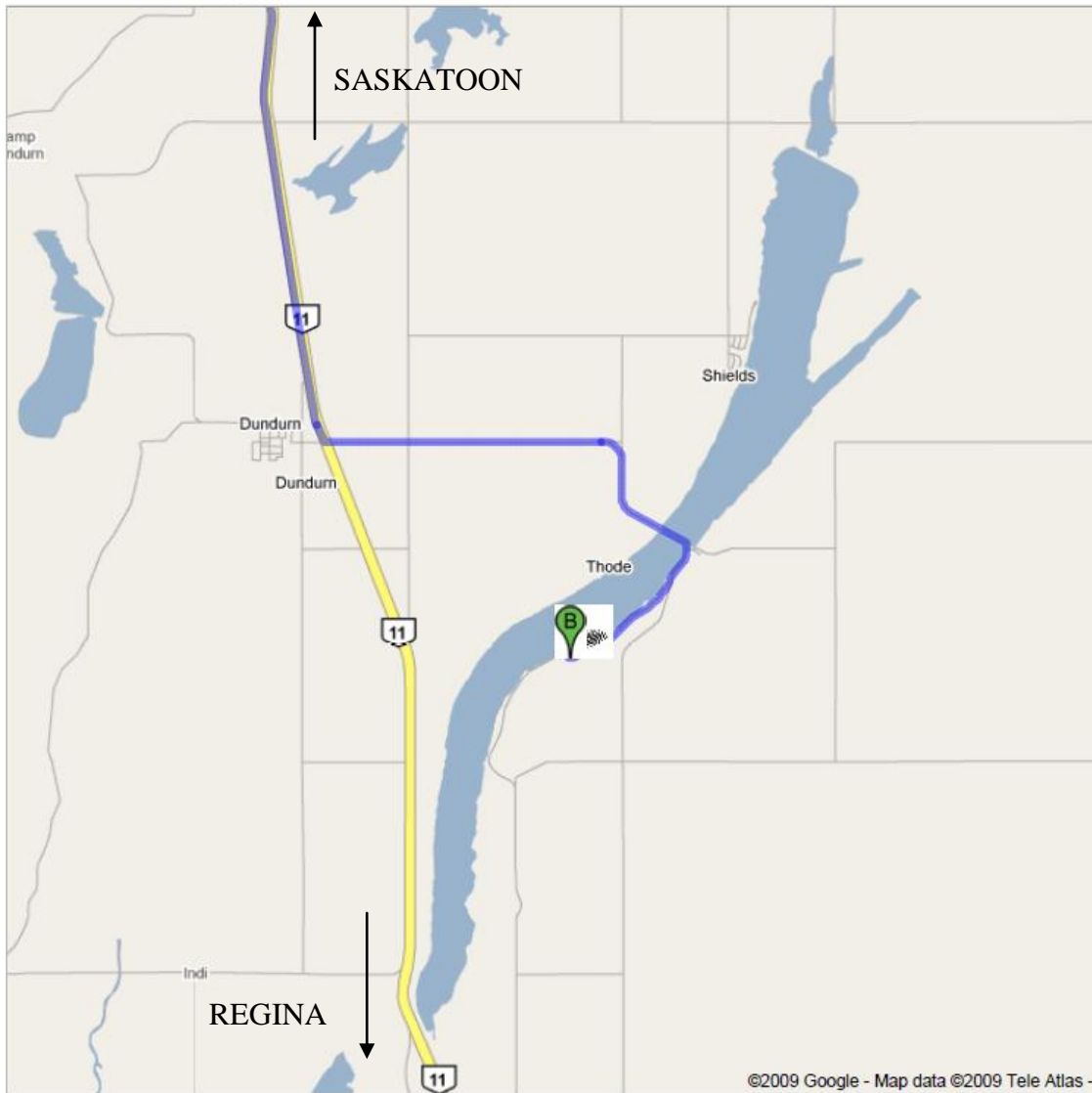

Parking:

Parking for both races is available in the parking lot in the Mountain View Picnic Area (see Map at the end of this document).

Pre-Register: \$20/race or \$35 for both days

The Courses

~~Enjoy the cross country ski trails that Blackstrap has been so carefully grooming all year. This course will take you through some rolling trails, onto a bit of technical terrain and into our prairie maze (new for this year).~~

Due to logistical problems, we will not be using the hill course. Saturday's race will be at the beach!! Spend one of fall's last Saturdays racing through the picnic areas at Blackstrap Park. The course will be raced in reverse on Sunday.

Back to the Beach (Sunday's Course):

Spend a day at the beach on this fantastic cross course which spans the area between the Mountain View Picnic Area and the Aspen Grove Picnic Area.

You Should Know:

- All riders must have a valid UCI/CCA license or purchase a 2 event-license at the event from the Commissaire (\$20)
- Riders are expected to know and understand the UCI Cyclo-cross rules.
- Please bring your race license and road racing body numbers. If you do not have body numbers, the SCA will provide those to you on race day.
- New 'cross racers will compete in the Cyclo-cross category corresponding to their respective Road or Mountain bike category (whichever is higher).
- Prizes will be awarded to 1st place (and random draw for the other placings). All pre-registered racers are eligible for random draw cash.



- Random prizes to be awarded. All competitors are eligible for draw prizes.
- Cyclo-cross bikes & mountain bikes are permitted in all categories.

Mechanical/Feed zone:

Feeding allowed ONLY if the Chief of Commissaires so declares. The bike/wheel pit will be at the start/finish line.

Number Placement

Please bring your race license, and road racing body numbers. If you do not have body numbers, the SCA will provide those for you on race day. Position both numbers on each the left and right side pockets (as per the illustration).



Cash Awards & Draw Prizes:

1st place in each category - \$20

1st random draw - \$15 (2-5 people in category)

2nd random draw - \$10 (6-12 people in category)

***Cash prizes are available to all who pre-register.**

In the event that 1st place did not pre-register (any day up until race day) the cash will go to the next pre-registered placing.

Awards will take place as soon as results are tabulated, after the last racer has completed the course (at approximately 12:45 PM), and will be handed out after lunch is served.
